I made some changes here that are more than simple edits. It's a really great start, however. Here are my thoughts and some gut, unfiltered, unfettered reactions:

- I would put our acronym in it, MPCSD, because we aren't just any public school district, and those not familiar with our schools, or worse, those who may get confused about what public schools they support, may not recognize our jurisdiction.
- I like "locally" better than community; community sounds like the community is solely on the hook for funding our schools, and this may prod someone to think, "What about parents donating more?" I have my paranoid hat on.
- I made some word changes to list of what the parcel tax will support, putting in another superlative, "excellent" on top of the already used word, "outstanding" and chose "uphold." In any case, I am sure you perseverated over the priority of this list of reasons.
- You see my word change and comment in brackets, suggesting slightly to change the word, "obligations" to
 expenses. I bet you avoided "pension" for sure, and "expenses" may not work as well as "obligations." Just
 thought I'd point out my thinking here. Moreover, let's not be accused of being evasive. This will play right into the
 hands of people saying, "Yep, looky there, they are hiding something and still not being transparent.
- Ironically, by saying "transparency measures," it looks like we will no longer hide facts and information, but we
 used to. We never did; In fact, we didn't market and communicate effectively. I'm not quite sure what
 transparency measures mean either. Are measures data? How about "accountability measures"? In this case, I
 mean being open about parcel tax funding and expenditures and do mean quantitative data (e.g., financial).

We are getting there and all the confluences of energy are sure going in the right direction.

Later this morning, I will provide you with the longer memo on campaign activity I mentioned last night, but in general District staff are free to participate in campaign activities as long as they do so on their own time without using District resources. In other words, you are free to talk with the campaign off District time and without using District resources (i.e., phones, email.). The same is true for Board members, although it is usually less of an issue for them.

At the same time, you are free at any time to provide information to the campaign that you would otherwise provide to another member of the public upon request and may use District resources to do so.

Hi Erik,

Below is the response from the County Registrar regarding the draft measure. It looks like we are pretty much good to go. The only question they had was whether we wanted a polling place or mail-in election. San Mateo is subject to special legislation that allows them to have mail-in elections on dates (including March 7) when other jurisdictions can only have polling place elections. I told him that our intention was to have a polling place election and that we could modify the resolution to make that more explicit if it would help and he said it would.

To do this I think we can make a few small revisions. In the first full "WHEREAS" on page 2, in "Order of Election" also on page 2, and in "Request to Registrar of Voters" on page 3 we can replace "an election" with "a polling place election."

I also left you a message if you want to discuss the best way for the Board to make this change, but procedurally it could be done by reading these revisions into the record during the meeting and then having the motion be to approve the resolution as modified.

Let me know if you have any questions about this or anything else before tonight's meeting.

Thanks so much for taking the time this morning to discuss the transition of the resolution from district staff to a campaign and the laws regarding communication of Board, campaign, district staff, and consultants/attorneys during a campaign.

As she shared with us, Stacey Wueste will be transitioning from the chair of the Concerned Parents group to the chair of a campaign.

The Superintendent's Advisory Committee on Communication will remain, although, it is my understanding that Stacey Wueste will remove herself from our committee until after the parcel tax campaign has ended. The Advisory Team will continue to advise the Board and Superintendent on informational communication to the public, as well as ensuring a tight timeline for reduction decisions prior to the March 15 deadline for releasing teachers. A big part of our job will be to keep the FAQ's on the district website updated and accessible.

As discussed, I have deleted the standing meeting invitation generated from my calendar prior to last night's vote. Stacey W agreed to email those who are able and need to be in future standing meeting calls. Should you need information from me or other staff in the district, you may invite me or a staff member to attend your meetings for information purposes only. I don't anticipate that will be needed often, but when it is, I will make myself available.

I wish Stacey W and her team all the best wishes, luck, juju in their efforts and thank them for their commitment to the district.

My understanding is that, now that we have voted to place a measure on the ballot, we must reorganize ourselves to provide for careful separation of campaign activities so that no District resources are used for advocacy activities not allowed under law. My understanding is that the District may certainly continue to pay for advice from consultants on our District communications activities related to our legally allowed activities. However, campaign activities must be paid for by the campaign, not the District. District employees such as yourself are welcome to participate in campaign meetings on your own time, but you cannot use any District resources to do so. As a salaried employee who is not "on the clock" you have the discretion to arrange your calendar to spend time on personal matters, so this means that you can arrange to take time off from your job with the District to participate in campaign activities such as conference calls or attend in person meetings. You cannot hold a an in person campaign meeting on District property since that would be using District resources. However, just as you are free to take time off from your work and make a personal phone call from your office to call your doctor or some other personal business, you can likewise call in to a campaign meeting from your office.

For tomorrow's call, please clarify at the start whether this call is a District activity or a campaign activity. If the former, then please ensure that we limit our activities to those allowed by law. If the latter, please confirm that the participation of Whitehurst is at the campaign's, and not the District's expense.

Please do provide whatever additional clarifications on all of this to all appropriate parties that our counsel advises.

Assuming the resolution is approved, below please find the steps for filing the resolution with the County officials:

- 1) Contact the County Superintendent's office to let them know the Board has adopted the resolution and will need the County Superintendent to sign the formal notice calling the election. Ask how many originals the District should bring to have signed (we would recommend four: one for the County Superintendent to retain, one for the County Elections Official, one for the Board of Supervisors and one for the District to retain.) You may want to do this today if you have not already.
- 2) No later than **Wednesday**, **December 7**, take originals of the signed resolution (with attachments) to the County Superintendent for her to sign the formal notice on each copy calling the election (Exhibit C to the resolution).
- 3) No later than **Friday, December 9**, deliver an original copy of the resolution and the signed formal notice to the County Elections Official/Registrar of Voters. Ask for a "received" stamped copy to be returned to the District if possible. You may want to call ahead to locate the appropriate office.
- 4) No later than **Friday, December 9**, deliver an original copy of the resolution and the signed formal notice to the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors. Ask for a "received" stamped copy to be returned to the District if possible. You may want to call ahead to locate the appropriate office.
- 5) Once the County Superintendent has signed the notice formally calling the election, Education Code, section 5362 requires the formal notice of the election be posted in every schoolhouse in the District as well as three additional locations in the District. The District can email copies of the signed resolution and notice to all school sites for posting, as well as posting it at the District office and two other public locations in the District.

Since this language has the basics of the tax I can use it as the basis for resolution/measure that we will revise next Monday and then present to the Board on the 30th. I plan to circulate the first draft tomorrow.

One thing I wanted to mention in reviewing the 75-word statement is that I would recommend that we include the total annual amount raised by the tax in the statement. The requirement to do so was added by law last year, and while there is some ambiguity that the requirement applies to school

districts, I would recommend that you include it in the statement to avoid any issues with the Registrar. In order to do this, we would need to determine the approximate annual amount to be raised by the tax and replace a few words in the 75-word statement with this amount. I will try to draft this language for incorporation into the resolution, but again we can discuss further next week.

If the Board decides to move forward on Thursday, I should be able to have a draft of the measure ready well in advance of the meeting on the 30th. As I mentioned on the call, if the Board would like to place a measure on the ballot the basic decisions they will need to make would be:

- 1) The amount of the tax (flat rate and CPI).
- 2) The duration of the tax.
- 3) The exemptions from the tax. The current tax has an exemption for seniors, the law now also allows for exemptions for those receiving Supplemental Security Income for a disability and for those receiving Social Security Disability Insurance below a certain income level. Most districts include all three exemptions in their measures, although it is not required.

With this information I can begin to put together the measure language and perhaps we can plan a call to go over a draft early next week or on the 28^{th} . If the Board is not ready to make these decisions Thursday, I can still put together the basic structure of the measure with placeholders until the 30^{th} .
